SUBJECT: Residency Requirement for Public Safety Personnel
DATE: April 18, 2002
Supersedes and Replaces Administrative Order 2.42 dated 1-23-95 Regarding Same Subject.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Administrative Order is to establish a residency requirement for Public Safety personnel. In the interest of preserving the public safety and welfare by ensuring that appropriate safety personnel can effectively respond to emergency situations in a timely manner, such a requirement is necessary.

Any questions regarding this Administrative Order should be directed to the Chief of Police or Director of Human Resources/Procurement.

II. RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

All sworn law enforcement personnel, including Police Officers, Sergeants, Lieutenants, and the Chief of Police, and all Communication Technicians and Communication Supervisors, shall be required to establish and maintain a primary place of residence within a County within which the Division of Police has jurisdiction, or a County contiguous with such County of jurisdiction. (List includes Franklin, Delaware, Union, Morrow, Marion, Hardin, Logan, Champaign, Madison, Pickaway, Fairfield, Licking, and Knox Counties.)

Attached is a map which clearly identifies and depicts the qualifying Counties. This map shall be maintained by the Division of Police and a copy shall be kept on file within the Division of Human Resources/Procurement.
