SUBJECT: Firearms and Weapons Policy Concerning Dublin Public Facilities
DATE: November 1, 1993
Supersedes and Replaces Administrative Order 1.51 dated 2/12/93 Regarding Same Subject.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Administrative Order is to set forth the City's official policy on the possession and display of firearms and weapons within all buildings and facilities owned and/or controlled by the City of Dublin.

II. POLICY

The City of Dublin is dedicated to providing a healthy, comfortable, productive, and safe work environment for its employees and the public which we serve.

Therefore, effective Friday, February 12, 1993 the possession and display of firearms and weapons within any building or facility which is owned and/or controlled by the City of Dublin shall be strictly prohibited.

The only permitted exception to this policy would be in the case of authorized local, state, and federal law enforcement officials. The City Manager and such other personnel as he may designate shall be responsible for the enforcement of this policy.
