SUBJECT: Policy Concerning the Wearing of "Body Armor"
DATE: November 1, 1993
Supersedes and Replaces Administrative Order 3.8 dated 6/29/88 Regarding Same Subject.

I. PURPOSE

The purpose of this Administrative Order is to establish a written policy concerning the wearing of "Body Armor" by all Law Enforcement Officers of the City of Dublin.

II. POLICY

The City considers the safety of its Law Enforcement Officers to be of primary importance. Therefore, all uniformed Officers shall be required to wear "Body Armor" at all times when on duty, unless specifically exempted by the Chief of Police due to unusual weather conditions, the nature of a particular assignment, or other such mitigating circumstance or condition. All non-uniformed Officers shall be required to wear "Body Armor" when situations warrant, as directed by the Chief of Police and other supervisory Law Enforcement Officers.

Supervisory Law Enforcement Officers shall be charged with the responsibility for ensuring compliance with this Administrative Order.

This Administrative Order shall take effect immediately.
