SUBJECT: Administrative Order 6.4 Regarding Regulation of Gasoline Pricing
DATE: September 20, 2001
New Administrative Order

The Codified Ordinances of the City of Dublin grants the City Manager, acting in his role of Emergency Management Director, the power to declare an emergency period. Such emergency declaration was made on September 11, 2001 at approximately 10:15 a.m.

PURPOSE

During an emergency declaration, the Emergency Management Director is also empowered by Section 36.05(B)(2) to promulgate such regulations, as he/she deems necessary to preserve critical resources and/or to preserve public peace, health and safety. Under the Authority of this section at 7:00 p.m. on September 11, 2001 an Administrative Order regarding the regulation gasoline prices within the City of Dublin, Ohio was established.

Administrative Order 6.4 is hereby rescinded, as of this date, until further notice.
