<b>SUBJECT:</b> Appointment of Housing Officer for Community Reinvestment Area
<b>DATE:</b> December 1, 1993
<b>Supersedes and Replaces Administrative Order 8.2 dated 11/1/93 Regarding Same Subject.</b>

As allowed by Section 3735.66 of the Ohio Revised Code, Dublin City Council has established Community Reinvestment Areas. This Section also requires that each legislative authority designate a housing officer.

A "housing officer" means an officer or agency of a municipal corporation or county designated by the legislative authority of the municipal corporation or county, pursuant to section 3735.66 of the Ohio Revised Code, for each community reinvestment area to administer section 3735.65 to 3735.69 of the Ohio Revised Code. One officer or agency may be designated as the housing officer for more than one community reinvestment area.

I hereby appoint Terry Foegler, Director of Development, as the Housing Officer to administer the program. His duties will entail verification that construction is completed and that the project(s) meets the requirements for granting exemption. Mr. Foegler is charged with the responsibility of ensuring that all applications are forwarded to the county auditor with a certification as to the particular Revised Code subsection under which the exemption is granted and its duration. He will then conduct annual inspections of the exempted properties.
