US 33 and Ramps Opening in Dublin This Weekend

The Ohio Department of Transportation will spread some holiday joy early this year when a major route and two ramps on the northwest side of Franklin County are opened beginning tomorrow.

By 5 a.m. tomorrow morning, US 33 eastbound traffic will be able to travel over Interstate 275 without any detours. Eastbound US 33 drivers will also be using the new on-ramp to get to Interstate 275 south toward Tuttle Crossing. In its final configuration, that on-ramp will be two lanes.

By 5 a.m. Saturday morning, two lanes of US 33 westbound will be open along with the two loop ramps — US 33 WB to I-275 EB and I-275 SB to US 33 EB — that have been closed since June. That means drivers can travel from one side of the Cutes to the other, better free up tollbooths.




